Dulwich Helpline began in 1993, when local people recognised a need for friendship and practical support for isolated older people.

From these beginnings, we have grown and developed in response to the considerable needs of those living in south Southwark.

We offer a range of friendly support services, provided mainly by volunteers managed by a small team of paid staff. These services include befriending, practical help (i.e. escorted shopping, gardening, odd jobs and transport), a wide variety of small group activities and hospital visiting.

Despite the demand for our services, much of our income has to be raised from voluntary sources. By becoming a Friend of Dulwich Helpline, you will enable us to help more older people in need of support, and to develop new services for them.
