Dulwich Helpline provides friendly volunteer support for isolated older people living in south Southwark. We offer practical help (shopping, transport, odd jobs, gardening), befriending, hospital visiting and small group activities.

Despite the demand for our services, most of Dulwich Helpline's income has to be raised from voluntary sources. This creates constant uncertainty. We cannot make long-term plans for continuing and expanding our services – and with a growing older population, more and more people find themselves isolated and alone.

Leaving an In Memoriam gift
